

Ecoblue Faults

All fault codes are shown as E with number(s) following.

If the code does not have an E prefix it is not a fault, it is an operating status code, boiler on/off or temperature etc. In these cases the user guide should be consulted.

In all cases the user should try to reset the boiler first; power cuts etc. can affect the normal boiler operation.

Fault codes that the end user may be able to clear

Code	Possible Fault	User Action.
110	Overheat	Check radiators are bled.
117	Water pressure too high	Bleed water from radiators.
118	Water pressure too low	Add water via filling loop.
125	Water circulation fault	Bleed radiators, check system water pressure and refill via a filling loop if low.
133	Safety time to establish flame exceeded	Check gas is turned on, if prepayment meter check there is credit. If all ok and this fault persists - contact an engineer to visit and investigate.
